

NovelRank Enterprise Edition Setup Documentation

Configure the Server

- Login to **PHPMyAdmin**, command line MySQL, or other MySQL manager
 - Create a new database (e.g. Name: **nree** | Encoding: **utf8-general-ci**)
- **[optional]** Configure PHP.INI file
 - (Via FTP) Go to /etc/php5/apache2 (or wherever your php.ini file is)
 - Edit php.ini
 - Set the following variables = **128M**
 - memory_limit, post_max_size, upload_max_filesize
 - Set the following variables = **90**
 - max_execution_time, max_input_time
 - Stop and Restart Apache (or reboot your server)

Install NovelRank Enterprise Edition

Unzip the contents of the attached .zip file. It will contain three folders of files (css/images/js) and three additional files (files.txt, install.php, and .htaccess). Upload these files and folders over to your server.

Note: *The software should be placed in its own subdomain or subdirectory (e.g. yourdomain.com/nree or nree.yourdomain.com).*

DO NOT install the software into a directory with existing files!

Once uploaded, go to the file **install.php** through your browser at the location you uploaded it (e.g. yourdomain.com/nree/install.php). Follow the instructions on the page to complete the installation.

Congratulations, in less than 5 minutes you have installed NovelRank Enterprise Edition!

Troubleshooting

- Ensure that the /var/www folder and all of it's files and subfolders are owned by the user **www-data** rather than root (User and Group Ownership). When setting up a new server on Amazon, this is not usually the case.
- The Apache modules **Headers** and **Rewrite** should be enabled
